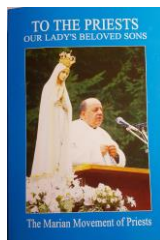
You can also consider becoming an Auxiliary member.

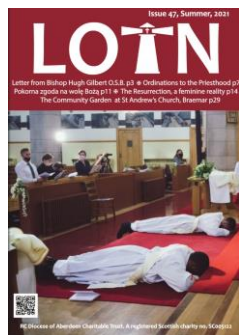
