PREGO is a weekly leaflet to help people pray the Sunday Mass Readings. There is an additional page (PREGO PLUS) providing simple background material on the two Scripture texts. Prego is produced by St Beuno's, a retreat centre in Wales. To aid spiritual development in adult Catholics they have produced a weekly pamphlet of reflections which are based on the Sunday readings.
